NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE DETERMINATION

Issued on: May 27, 2011

On February 11, 2010, The Department of Energy (DOE) issued a Test Notice to Electrolux Home Products, Inc. (Electrolux) for Electrolux's Frigidaire chest freezer model FFN09M5HWC (subject model). This model was a subject of DOE's Energy Star[®] Verification Testing Pilot Program, the results of which indicated that the model may not meet applicable energy conservation standards.

A third-party lab, CSA International in Toronto, performed enforcement testing on five units of the subject model. DOE received data from enforcement testing on four units on March 29, 2011, and on the fifth unit on May 11, 2011. Based on these test results and the outcome of the statistical analysis process as detailed in Appendix B to Subpart F of 10 CFR Part 430,¹ this model is in compliance with the DOE Standard.

DOE has determined that Electrolux's Frigidaire chest freezer model FFN09M5HWC complies with the applicable energy conservation standard. This case is now closed.

¹ At the time of the suspected violation, the applicable regulations for certification and enforcement testing to determine whether a basic model of a covered product complies with the applicable energy conservation standard were located in Appendix B to Subpart F of 10 CFR Part 430. These regulations were recodified on March 7, 2011, and are now located at Subpart C of 10 CFR Part 429. 76 FR 12422 (Mar. 7, 2011).
