Description:

**B5.1** Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

Rational for determination:

The Project Activity Sheet (PAS) #8 titled Electric Vehicle Charging Station submitted by the City of Raleigh, North Carolina, involves the installation of two (2) electric vehicle (EV) charging stations within the City. One of these EV charging stations to be located at 285 Hargett Street was previously reviewed and received a categorical exclusion determination. The second EV charging station location was not identified at the time the first EV charging station was reviewed, and so was not included in the original categorical exclusion.

The City of Raleigh has now identified the location of the second EV charging station as 184 Lenoir Street, which is the address of the Raleigh Convention Center. This location is owned by the City of Raleigh, and is a previously disturbed site in an urban area. The EV charging station will be used in conjunction with the City's fleet vehicles that will be converted to electric power.

The second EV charging station location under PAS #8 is bounded by the signed SOW and is therefore categorically excluded under NEPA.

Any projects submitted for EECBG funding that fall outside the bounds of the signed SOW will require a separate NEPA determination.
