Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Order 451.1A), I have made the following determination:

## Description:

**B5.1** Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

## Rational for determination:

The Project Activity Sheet (PAS) titled "Chester Valley Trail Extension and Trailhead" submitted by the County of Chester, Pennsylvania, involves the construction of an 0.25-mile extension to an existing bike and pedestrian trail, and trailhead access facilities. The trail extension would be constructed to a width of 12 feet with a 2-foot graded shoulder on each side utilizing an existing gravel-packed railroad right-of-way. The trailhead access facilities would include: new paved access drive to a paved parking lot with 43 parking spaces; new stormwater management facilities; and new landscape plantings on County-owned property.

A State General NPDES permit (PAG-2001507010) has been issued for the project, and was approved on May 14, 2007. The Erosion & Sediment Control Plan for the project was approved on May 14, 2007, and has been extended to 2012, running concurrently with the NPDES permit.

All work will be completed within an existing railroad utility right-of-way where vegetation is routinely cut back or sprayed to avoid overhead line interference. There are no areas of woody vegetation that will be impacted by the proposed construction. The site will be restored and stabilized by planting turf grass for lawn areas and the trail shoulders. The stormwater infiltration basins will be seeded with a native meadow seed mixture that will require mowing only once a year. In addition, numerous trees and shrubs will be planted per the requirement of the Township ordinance. The stormwater management facilities have been designed and approved by West Whiteland Township in accordance with their local ordinance and the County has entered into a stormwater management maintenance agreement with the Township. The Recipient has confirmed that no improvements will be constructed within a floodplain area.

The project has been cleared through the Pennsylvania Natural History Inventory (PNDI) system. Clearance of endangered and threatened species was required to obtain the NPDES permit. The West Whiteland Township also considered the proposed improvements in relation to cultural and historic resources as a component of their land development approval process.

The Chester Valley Trail Extension and Trailhead, as described in the revised PAS, is categorically excluded from further NEPA review under B5.1.
