## Description:

- B5.1** Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.
- B3.6** Siting, construction (or modification), operation, and decommissioning of facilities for indoor bench-scale research projects and conventional laboratory operations (for example, preparation of chemical standards and sample analysis); small-scale research and development projects; and small-scale pilot projects (generally less than two years) conducted to verify a concept before demonstration actions. Construction (or modification) will be within or contiguous to an already developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible).
- A9** Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, audits), data analysis (including computer modeling), document preparation (such as conceptual design or feasibility studies, analytical energy supply and demand studies), and dissemination (including, but not limited to, document mailings, publication, and distribution; and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring.

## Rational for determination:

Morehead State University proposes to use federal funding to analyze volumes and distributions of wood residues in eastern Kentucky, quantify production of switchgrass and sweet sorghum as well as management issues, evaluate densification in the region, and conduct a conference outlining findings from these studies.

This project will involve quantifying the availability of wood residues in the region and the availability of idle farm and pastureland in the region; evaluation of the production potential, net energy balance, and economics of growing switchgrass and sweet sorghum in the region through field demonstration, purchase of a pellet mill system to evaluate feasibility of producing biomass pellets using feedstocks in the region, and conduct a 1 day conference in the region to provide the results.

This work will be conducted within laboratories and university research farm at the University of Kentucky. The applicant has submitted an R & D study which thoroughly addresses chemical and safety handling protocols.

This project comprises of information gathering and dissemination, conventional laboratory studies, and actions to conserve energy, therefore a CX B5.1, A9, & B3.6 will apply.


