Description:

Rational for determination:

The State of Indiana will provide \$4,000,000 in Recovery Act funds to Caterpillar, Inc. for the purchase of equipment to modify the engine production lines at its existing facility located at 3701 State Road 26, Lafayette, Indiana 47905 (Tippecanoe County).

The recipient intends to upgrade three engineering test cells and one production test cell, as well as upgrading crankshaft production. The upgrades will increase the production capability of the plant and result in a manufacturing process that produces engines with reduced emissions. The recipient does not anticipate the need for new or modified plant permits. The equipment and manufacturing improvements complement work already ongoing at the plant. The work will not increase the footprint of the facility.

In view of the information provided by the State and recipient, DOE has determined that the work outlined is consistent with activities identified in Categorical Exclusion B5.1.
