Description:

- B3.6** Siting, construction (or modification), operation, and decommissioning of facilities for indoor bench-scale research projects and conventional laboratory operations (for example, preparation of chemical standards and sample analysis); small-scale research and development projects; and small-scale pilot projects (generally less than two years) conducted to verify a concept before demonstration actions. Construction (or modification) will be within or contiguous to an already developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible).
- A9** Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, audits), data analysis (including computer modeling), document preparation (such as conceptual design or feasibility studies, analytical energy supply and demand studies), and dissemination (including, but not limited to, document mailings, publication, and distribution; and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring.

Rational for determination:

The City of Allentown, PA proposes to use federal funding to design a Municipal Solid Waste and sludge processing plant and test the feasibility via bench scale laboratory work. Their overall project consists of 4 phases, pre-installation, construction, systematic testing, and plant commissioning. This NEPA determination applies to Phase 1, Task 1.0 – Task 4.0 only.

Phase 1 tasks:

- Task 1.1 Basic & detailed engineering to meet the process standards
- Task 1.2 Design review on the above engineering steps
- Task 1.3 Bench scale test system review
- Task 1.4 Oversight engineering to assure all EPA and DEP standards are met
- Task 1.5 Complete sign off on all engineering phase
- Task 1.6 Process safety review
- Task 1.7 Independent review of technologies
- Task 2.0 Acquisition of required permits
- Task 3.0 Environmental Analysis
- Task 4.0 Project management and reporting.

The applicant has submitted an R & D questionnaire to address laboratory research studies, which thoroughly addresses all chemical and safety handling protocols.

This project comprises of information gathering and bench scale research to test the system; therefore a CX A9 & B3.6 will apply.

NEPA PROVISION

DOE has made a conditional NEPA determination for this award, and funding for certain tasks under this award is contingent upon the final NEPA determination.

Phase 1, Tasks 1 - 4.


