Description:

- A9** Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, audits), data analysis (including computer modeling), document preparation (such as conceptual design or feasibility studies, analytical energy supply and demand studies), and dissemination (including, but not limited to, document mailings, publication, and distribution; and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring.
- B3.6** Siting, construction (or modification), operation, and decommissioning of facilities for indoor bench-scale research projects and conventional laboratory operations (for example, preparation of chemical standards and sample analysis); small-scale research and development projects; and small-scale pilot projects (generally less than two years) conducted to verify a concept before demonstration actions. Construction (or modification) will be within or contiguous to an already developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible).

Rational for determination:

This NEPA review is a continuation of GFO-09-052 for the NEPA clearance of Phase 2 of the original project. This NEPA determination applies to Phase 2 of this award. Phase 2 of the project will entail component development, integrated model development, component testing, performance and economic analysis, and reporting.

Analytical work and bench-top experiments will take place at Abengoa Solar Inc. to study thermal conductivity enhancements. The component testing task work will take place at Oak Ridge National Laboratory (ORNL) for corrosion testing of typical heat exchanger materials. ORNL is responsible for the completion of the NEPA review for the portion of the project to be completed at ORNL.

The applicant has submitted an R & D questionnaire for work performed at Abengoa Solar Inc. which thoroughly addresses the chemical and safety handling protocols associated with this projects laboratory research.

This project is comprised of information gathering and bench scale research and development activities; therefore a CX A9 & B3.6 will apply.
