Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Order 451.1A), I have made the following determination:

Description:

B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

Rational for determination:

The Texas State Energy Conservation Office is proposing to use \$23,030 in EECBG funding to replace three, existing motors on pumps at three existing well sites with new, energy efficient motors. The three well sites are located in developed areas of the City of Pottsboro, Texas.

There will be no ground disturbance or new construction as a result of the proposed project; therefore, there will be no adverse effects to threatened and endangered species, wetlands, floodplains or cultural resources as these resources are not present at the proposed sites. The State has a contract with each recipient that includes the SHPO/Waste Stream requirements that each recipient is fully aware of and must perform.

The proposed project is consistent with activities outlined in B5.1 "actions to conserve energy"; therefore, it is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.


