Description:

B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

Rational for determination:

The Kansas Energy Office (KEO) would administer the SEP Program for Kansas. KEO would allocate \$6,875,000 in DOE funding to the following sub-recipients:

- Emporia State University Energy Efficiency Project (\$900,000)
- Kansas State University Energy Efficiency Project (\$2,600,000)
- Kansas University Medical Center (\$900,000)
- Kansas University Energy Efficiency Upgrades (\$975,000)
- Pittsburg State University Energy Efficiency Upgrades (\$1,500,000)

The proposed projects are bounded in compliance with the uploaded and signed SEP Template for expedited NEPA review. Any projects that fall outside the scope of the template are conditioned pending further NEPA review.

These projects comprise actions to conserve energy including energy efficiency retrofits; therefore they are categorized under CX B5.1.
