## Rational for determination:

DOE is proposing to provide federal funding to the City of San Antonio to support local and regional efforts to address and achieve measurable improvements in market conditions for both commercial and residential rooftop photovoltaic (PV) solar arrays.

DOE funding would be used to develop and implement a transparent, consistent, and expedient permitting and interconnection process for residential and small commercial rooftop PV systems throughout all participating jurisdictions; improve interconnection and net metering for the primary load-serving utility in each participating jurisdiction; increase distributed PV market activity and resolve legal issues around third party ownership models.

Based on this information, DOE has determined the work outlined is consistent with activities identified in categorical exclusion A9 (information gathering, analysis and dissemination) and A11 (technical advice and assistance to organizations).
