Description:

- A9 Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination** Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. - A11 Technical advice and assistance to organizations** Technical advice and planning assistance to international, national, state, and local organizations.

Rational for determination:

DOE is proposing to provide federal funding to the Hudson Valley Community College (HVCC) to continue advancing the Northeast Photovoltaic Regional Training Provider project. DOE funding would be used to develop a curriculum that supports the solar photovoltaic (PV) educational "Train the Trainer" program.

This NEPA determination applies to Phases 2 – 4. DOE made a previous determination (GFO-10-237; CX A9, A11 and B5.1; signed 3.4.2010) for Phase 1. Partial funding from Phase 1 was used to build a \$1.5 million renewable energy training facility. Construction on the facility was completed in August 2011. No additional construction would occur during Phases 2 - 4. The proposed project would involve developing a curriculum and outreach activities to train the solar PV instructors and students at HVCC (345 Hermes Road, Malta, New York 12020).

Based on this information, DOE has determined the work outlined is consistent with activities identified in categorical exclusion A9 (information gathering, analysis and dissemination) and A11 (technical advice and assistance to organizations).
