Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Order 451.1A), I have made the following determination:

Description:

B3.6 Small-scale research and development, laboratory operations, and pilot projects

Siting, construction, modification, operation, and decommissioning of facilities for smallscale research and development projects; conventional laboratory operations (such as preparation of chemical standards and sample analysis); and small-scale pilot projects (generally less than 2 years) frequently conducted to verify a concept before demonstration actions, provided that construction or modification would be within or contiguous to a previously disturbed or developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible). Not included in this category are demonstration actions, meaning actions that are undertaken at a scale to show whether a technology would be viable on a large scale and suitable for commercial deployment.

Rational for determination:

DOE is proposing to provide federal funding to PPG Industries Inc. (PPG) to perform laboratory research and development activities on high performance reflector panels for concentrating solar power operations.

DOE made a previous NEPA determination (GFO-08-049; B3.6; 3-19-2008), which restricted PPG from conducting performance and durability field-test validation with unidentified end-users in Phase II. This determination identifies one of the selected end-users, eSolar.

This NEPA determination applies to Phase II – performance and durability field-testing. Testing would be completed by eSolar at existing facilities located at Palmdale Operations Center (POC), 150 Grand Cypress Avenue, Palmdale, California 93551.

PPG Industries would send mirrors to eSolar to test for reflector flatness and manufacturing quality. The mirror sizes would be 31-1/2 inches x 55-29/32 inches x 3.2 mm, 10 non-tempered and 2 tempered samples.

eSolar completed an R&D questionnaire addressing the protocols for laboratory safety, risk management, chemical handling and waste disposal. eSolar complies with standard laboratory safety procedures. Labs are inspected by safety personnel. eSolar has all applicable permits in place to conduct research on site. No additional permits are needed for project activities. The laboratory general safety procedures would be followed. Personal protective equipment would be worn when necessary.

Based on review of project information and the above analysis, DOE has determined the research would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or environment. DOE has determined the proposed project is consistent with the actions contained in DOE categorical exclusion B3.6 "small-scale research and development," and is categorically excluded from further NEPA review under CX B3.6.

Any further projects will require a separate NEPA determination review.
