Description:

A9 Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. Rational for determination:

This NEPA review is being conducted for subtask 1.1.1, as outlined in the revised SOPO for Florida Atlantic University's (FAU) project. FAU has received Congressionally Directed Funding for this project and all tasks, but this subtask, have been determined to be consistent with DOE's categorical exclusions.

Subtask 1.1.1 was originally held until further information was available. FAU has revised subtask 1.1.1 to support regulatory and permitting activities. The original scope of this task involved using funding to develop FAU's proposed floating platform and barge. This activity is no longer being supported by this award and has been removed from the project scope.

Task description:

Subtask 1.1.1 – Regulatory, Permitting, and Licensing

Task 1.1.1 would include travel and staffing salaries needed to obtain the necessary leases, permits, environmental data collection, and permissions from the Bureau of Ocean Energy Management and the NOAA's National Marine Fisheries Service to assist the regulatory process for their proposed small-scale ocean current test facilities.

Activities would include project research, information gathering, site visits, and information dissemination. These activities are consistent with DOE's categorical exclusion A9 (Information gathering, data analysis, document preparation, and information dissemination).
