Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. Rational for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) provided \$686,000.00 of federal funding to the State of Wisconsin under the DOE's Annually Appropriated State Energy Program (SEP) for 2012. Wisconsin will match the federal funding with \$137,570 in state funds. Additionally, Wisconsin will carry over \$50,000 in federal appropriations, for a total of \$873,570.

Wisconsin proposes to fund the following market titles:

Clean Energy Manufacturing Revolving Loan Fund:

This loan fund would be carried over from Wisconsin's DOE's American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 State Energy Program. This loan fund will be entering into its second revolution and projects selected under this loan fund will receive individual NEPA review and determinations. This Market Title is conditioned pending additional NEPA review.

Continuing Initiatives and Policy Development:

Wisconsin would administer its 2012 annual appropriations and conduct educational activities and outreach under this Market Title.

Wisconsin Public Benefits Initiatives:

This Market Title would promote the relationship between Wisconsin's State Energy Office and the Public Benefits program. There is no federal funding associated with this Market Title and it would primarily be used for data exchange between the two agencies.

Based on a review of the activities that would be funded under "Clean Energy Manufacturing Revolving Loan Fund" DOE has conditioned this Market Title pending additional NEPA review. Based on a review of the activities that would be funded under the "Continuing Initiatives and Policy Development" and "Wisconsin Public Benefits Initiatives" Market Titles, DOE has determined the projects that would be funded under these Market Titles will not significantly impact the human environment and they are categorically excluded from further NEPA review under CX A9 "information gathering" and CX A11 "technical advice."

NEPA PROVISION

DOE has made a conditional NEPA determination for this award, and funding for certain tasks under this award is contingent upon the final NEPA determination.

Insert the following language in the award:

You are restricted from taking any action using federal funds, which would have an adverse affect on the environment or limit the choice of reasonable alternatives prior to DOE/NNSA providing either a NEPA clearance or a final NEPA decision regarding the project.

Prohibited actions include:

This restriction does not preclude you from:

If you move forward with activities that are not authorized for federal funding by the DOE Contracting Officer in advance of the final NEPA decision, you are doing so at risk of not receiving federal funding and such costs may not be recognized as allowable cost share.


