## Rational for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) provided \$208,000 of federal funding to the State of Hawaii (Hawaii) under the DOE's Annually Appropriated State Energy Program (SEP) for 2012. Hawaii will match the federal funding with \$41,600 in state funds and will carry over \$283,000 in federal funds.

Hawaii proposes to fund the following Market Titles:

## Administration:

Under this Market Title, Hawaii would utilize federal funding to update scenario analyses will be updated to inform the public, policymakers, and renewable energy developers on how HCEI goals can be most efficiently met in light of recent technological innovations and resource assessments. This program is strictly administrative in nature.

## Energy Education:

Under this Market Title, Hawaii would utilize federal funding to implement programs and activities that would facilitate investment, policy, and regulatory frameworks to enable the development of clean energy business and the growth of new jobs for Hawaii. This would be accomplished through statewide presentations, workshops, seminars, expos, conferences and summits and the use of strategic media relations activities. This program is strictly administrative in nature.

## Energy Efficient Buildings:

Under this Market Title, Hawaii would utilize federal funding to provide technical assistance to public (state and county governments), private building owners, and non-profit building owners. This program is strictly administrative in nature.

Based on a review of the activities that would be funded under the above Market Titles, DOE has determined the projects that would be funded under these Market Titles will not significantly impact the human environment and they are categorically excluded from further NEPA review under CX A9 "information gathering" and CX A11 "technical advice." Any activities funded under the 2012 annual appropriations that involve ground-breaking activities, retrofits, or equipment purchase and/or installation are conditioned pending additional NEPA review.


