**Rational for determination:**

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide federal funding to the Midwest Energy Efficiency Alliance (MEEA) to provide regional support and technical assistance for DOE Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy (EERE) programs.

MEEA would support the EERE program areas of Advanced Manufacturing Office, Building Technologies Program, Office of Strategic Programs and Weatherization and Intergovernmental Programs. MEEA would utilize funding to collect best practices, case studies and data to provide the impact of EERE funds, organize meetings, conferences and events, workforce development and training, gather and analyze Evaluation Measurement and Verification information, and prepare educational and outreach documents and webpages.

Based on review of the project information and the above analysis, DOE has determined the activities would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or environment. DOE has determined the proposed project is consistent with the actions contained in DOE categorical exclusion A9 "information gathering, analysis, and dissemination," and A11 "technical advice and assistance," and is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.

Any activities funded under the appropriations that involve ground-breaking activities, retrofits, or equipment purchase and/or installation are conditioned pending additional NEPA review. Any further projects will require a separate NEPA determination review.
