Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Order 451.1A), I have made the following determination:

CX, EA, EIS APPENDIX AND NUMBER:

Description:

A9 Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. A11 Technical advice and assistance to organizations Technical advice and planning assistance to international, national, state, and local organizations.

Rational for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) provided \$142,000 of federal funding to Guam under the DOE's Annually Appropriated State Energy Program (SEP) for 2012. Guam will carry over \$290,592 of prior year SEP funding.

Guam proposes to fund the following market titles:

Administration:

Under this Market Title, Guam would use federal funding to administer and supervise its SEP funding. Additionally, funding would be used to distribute information on energy efficiency and renewable energy. If federal funding is used for installation of energy efficient and/or renewable energy projects, those projects will be submitted for additional NEPA review.

Energy Education Outreach and Training:

Under this Market Title, Guam would use federal funding to conduct various outreach with the public that focus on practicing energy conservation and promoting energy efficiency activities. "Mini-training sessions" on energy efficiency technologies would be conducted as well as holding energy awareness activities in conjunction of the National Energy Month.

Fuel Demand, Inventory and Distribution Framework:

Under this Market Title, Guam would use federal fund to gather data on fuel consumption and prices, monitor Guam's fuel needs, provide guidance that would address fuel shortages, conduct analysis on current fuel tax laws and transportation usage, and to promote energy efficiency vehicles for government use.

Based on a review of the activities that would be funded under the above Market Titles, DOE has determined the projects that would be funded under these Market Titles will not significantly impact the human environment and they are categorically excluded from further NEPA review under CX A9 "information gathering" and CX A11 "technical advice." Any activities funded under the 2012 annual appropriations that involve ground-breaking activities, retrofits, or equipment purchase and/or installation are conditioned pending additional NEPA review.


