1. PROJECT/ACTIVITY TITLE: East Gate (Greenville Road) and Vasco Gate (East Ave) Kiosk Modifications, LLNL Livermore Site	DATE: March 18, 2015
2. PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The proposed project would modify the East Gate entrance to allow for two-lane entry to the Livermore site with two badge-check security kiosks, as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reconfigure the existing three lanes to two lanes with new stripes and signs • Install a new concrete pad to allow for a new entry kiosk • Relocate an existing kiosk from Vasco Road entrance (East Ave entrance) to the new concrete pad at East Gate • Provide electricity and data lines from UC Davis building, Trailer 6675 (T6675). Trenching will be approx. 24-inch-deep and approx. 75-yards-long. The excavated soil will be reused to compact the trench, while any excavated asphalt will be disposed of according to LLNL procedures (and sent to Altamont Landfill) • Electricity will be tapped into an existing electrical switchgear at T6675 • The swing gate will be reconfigured to allow for the two lane entry configuration • Bollards will be installed (approx. 5) around the new kiosk location • A new kiosk will be installed at Vasco Road entrance on the existing concrete pad at that location (the kiosk will be delivered by a vendor from an offsite manufacturing site) 	
3. Categorical Exclusion(s) Applied: B1.32 Traffic flow adjustments. Traffic flow adjustments to existing roads (including, but not limited to, stop sign or traffic light installation, adjusting direction of traffic flow, and adding turning lanes), and road adjustments (including, but not limited to, widening and realignment) that are within an existing right-of-way and consistent with approved land use or transportation improvement plans. B1.22 Relocation of buildings. Relocation of buildings (including, but not limited to, trailers and prefabricated buildings) to an already developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible). B1.15 Support buildings. Siting, construction or modification, and operation of support buildings and support structures (including, but not limited to, trailers and prefabricated and modular buildings) within or contiguous to an already developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible).	


