Proposed Action Title: Zone 11 Interconnect Replacement

Program or Field Office: NNSA Production Office (Pantex)

Location(s) (City/County/State): Amarillo, Carson, Texas

Proposed Action Description:

This project would remove and replace the existing 15-kilovolt (KV) Zone 11 electrical interconnect due to a weather event in 2015 that caused an arc fault event that resulted in catastrophic damage to the switchgear. Currently the Zone 11 switchgear house has been electrically removed from the Plant's electrical distribution system. The existing switchgear housing, equipment, and foundations would be demolished and replaced with a new foundation, a prefabricated modular building, and new equipment. Two (2) existing Manual Transfer Switches (MTS) would be reused for this upgrade.

If changes are made to the proposed scope of action so that it is no longer bound by the action described in the original documentation, as amended, or is expanded to encompass other actions, NEPA requirements for the action will need to be reassessed at that time and further NEPA analysis may be required.

The proposal fits within a class of actions that is listed in Appendix A or B to 10 CFR Part 1021, Subpart D.

There are no extraordinary circumstances related to the proposal that may affect the significance of the environmental effects of the proposal.

The proposal has not been segmented to meet the definition of a categorical exclusion. This proposal is not connected to other actions with potentially significant impacts (40 CFR 1508.25(a)(1)), is not related to other actions with individually insignificant but cumulatively significant impacts (40 CFR 1508.27(b)(7)), and is not precluded by 40 CFR 1506.1 or 10 CFR 1021.211 concerning limitations on actions during preparation of an environmental impact statement.

Based on my review of the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (as authorized under DOE Order 451.1B), I have determined that the proposed action fits within the specified class(es) of action, the other regulatory requirements set forth above are met, and the proposed action is hereby categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
