Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Federal Energy Management Program (FEMP) is proposing to provide federal funding to the International Institute for Sustainable Laboratories (I2SL) in support of a 3-year project to support DOE's Better Buildings Smart Lab Accelerator Partners.

I2SL would provide the resources to identify and provide prospective Smart lab Accelerator partners, coordinate with the DOE to ensure the program goals are met, and develop a set of tools, guides and training workshops that can be utilized by the partners and the laboratory general industry.

Project activities would involve promotion of DOE's Better Buildings Smart Lab Accelerator Program, identifying partners for the program, providing support to these partners, and developing a series of tools, guides and educational workshops that support the goals of the program. Activities would be limited to intellectual, academic, and analytical activities.

Based on the review of the proposal, DOE has determined the proposal fits within the class of action(s) selected above. DOE has also determined that: (1) there are no extraordinary circumstances (as defined by 10 CFR 1021.410(2)) related to the proposal that may affect the significance of the environmental effects of the proposal; (2) the proposal has not been segmented to meet the definition of a categorical exclusion; and (3) the proposal is not connected to other actions with potentially significant impacts, related to other proposals with cumulatively significant actions, or an improper interim action. This proposal is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
