Description:

Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide federal funding to the Community Action Partnership to assist local WAP organizations in expanding and diversifying their private sector partnerships by leveraging the infrastructure and quality of the WAP with others' resources to expand services.

Activities associated with the proposed project would include online research, organization of virtual and in-person meetings, conference calls, and general office work at the Washington DC office location. Trainings in the form of lectures and small group discussions would be provided in various states at locally hosted meetings and conferences. Products created from the project would be limited to presentations and guides hosted online and printed as necessary.

Based on the review of the proposal, DOE has determined the proposal fits within the class of action(s) selected above. DOE has also determined that: (1) there are no extraordinary circumstances (as defined by 10 CFR 1021.410(2)) related to the proposal that may affect the significance of the environmental effects of the proposal; (2) the proposal has not been segmented to meet the definition of a categorical exclusion; and (3) the proposal is not connected to other actions with potentially significant impacts, related to other proposals with cumulatively significant actions, or an improper interim action. This proposal is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
