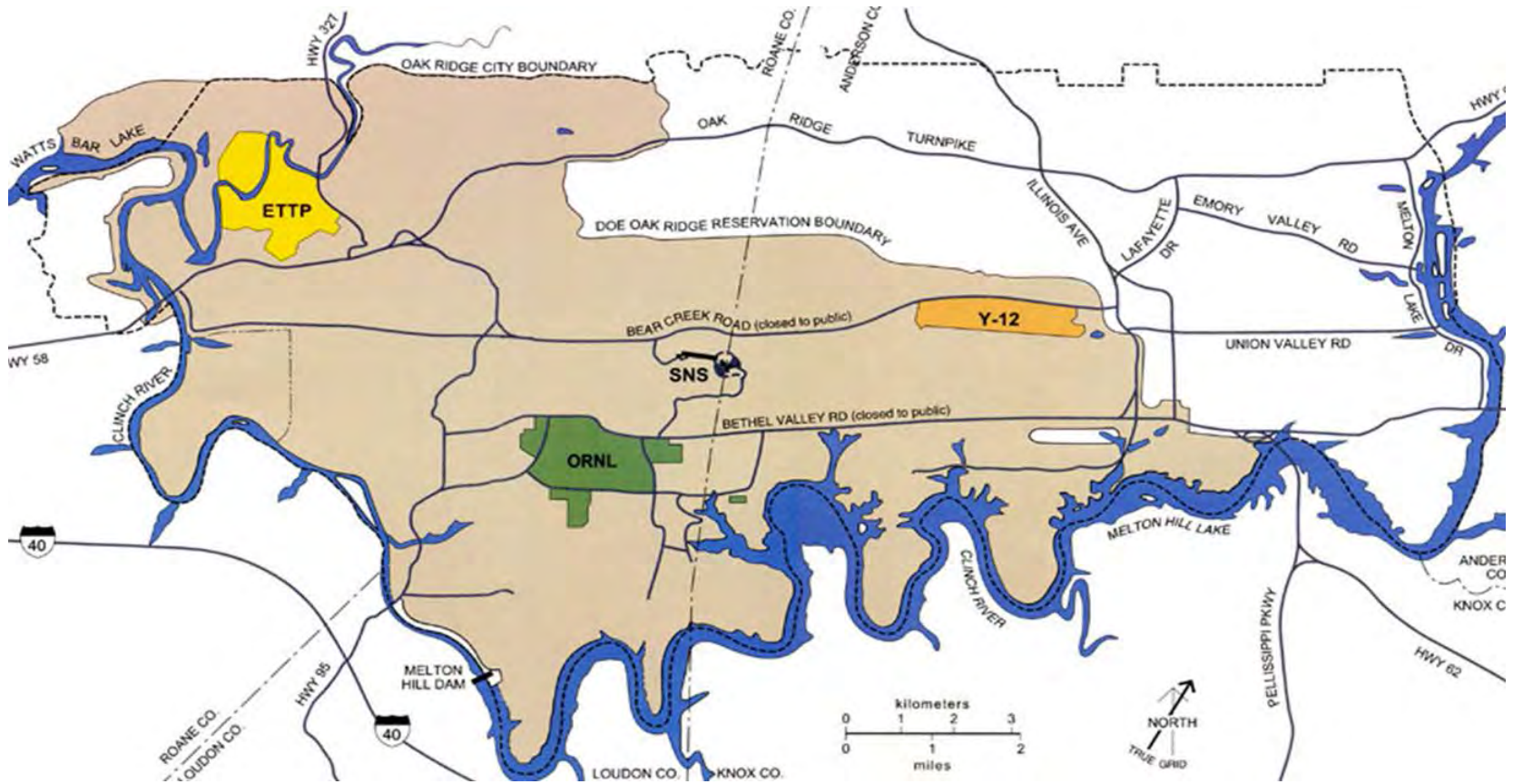

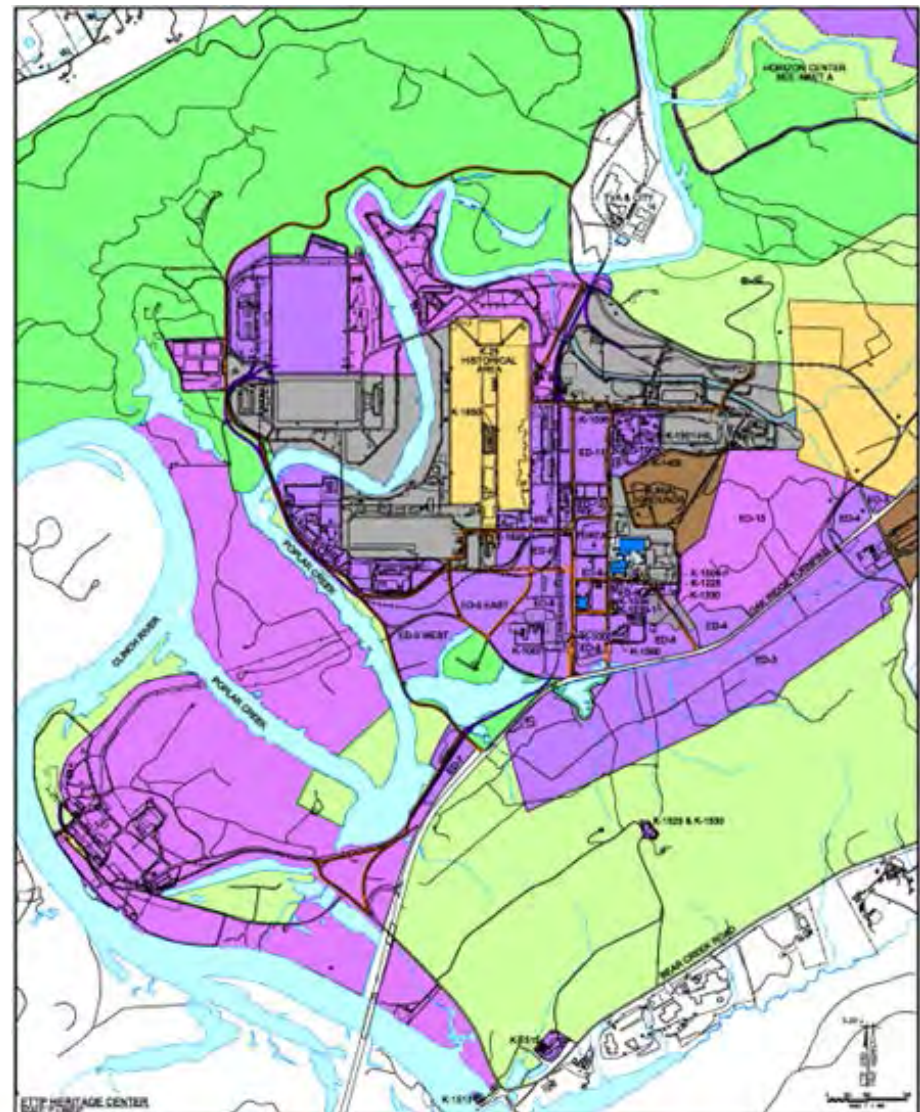

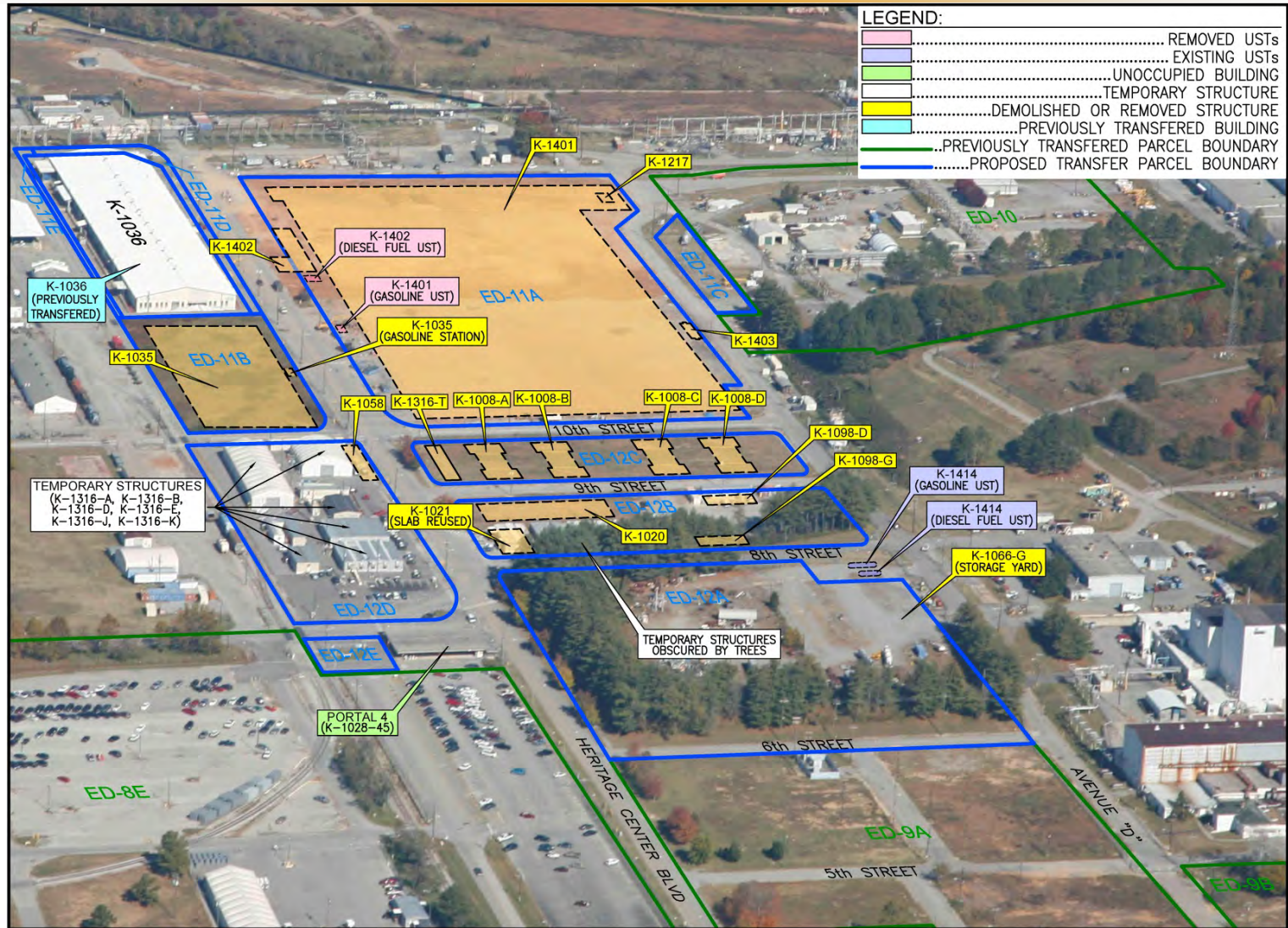
Roads Transferred to the City

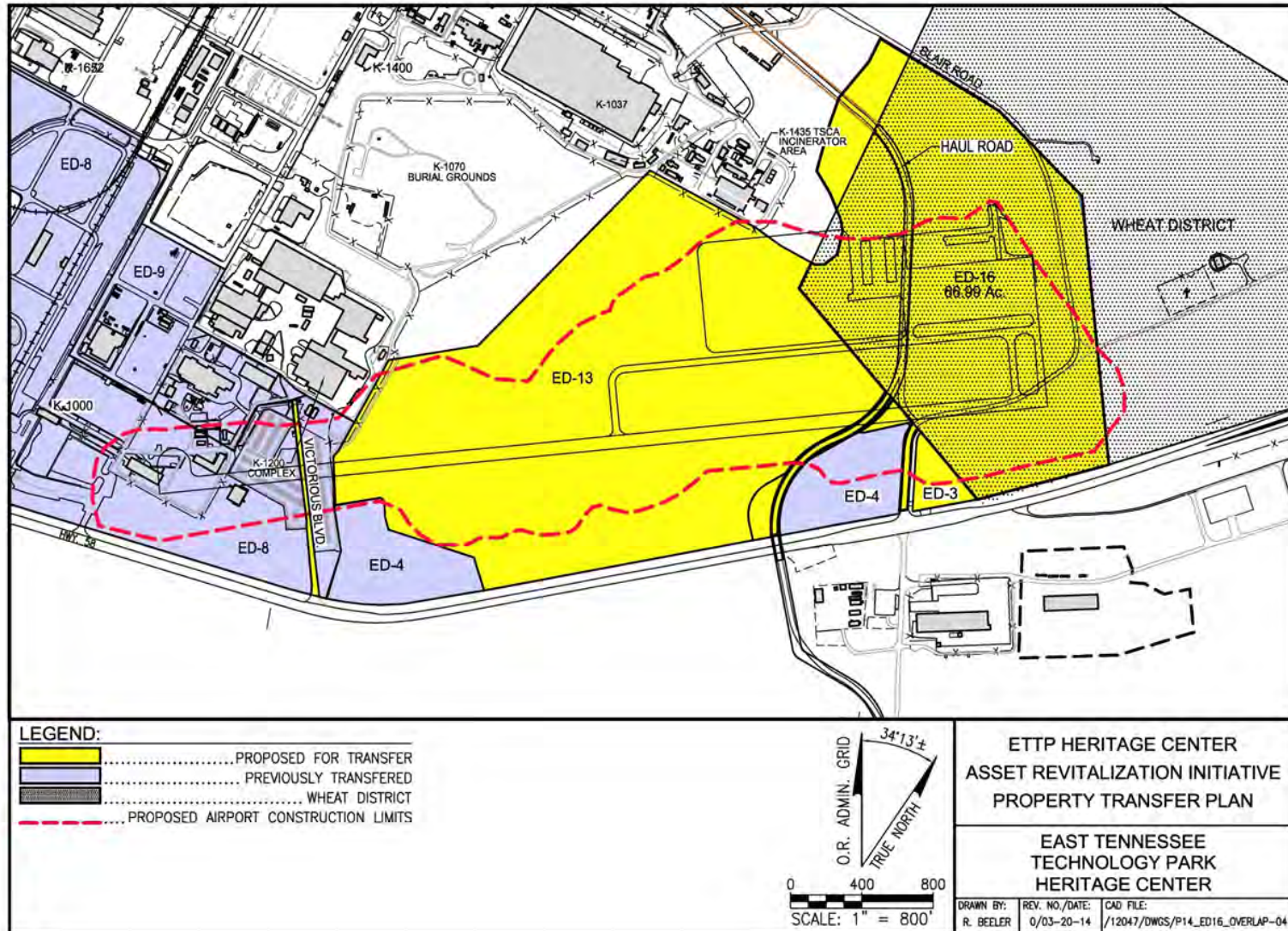


Transfer of Parcels ED-11 and ED-12

Proposed Airport Transfer Footprint

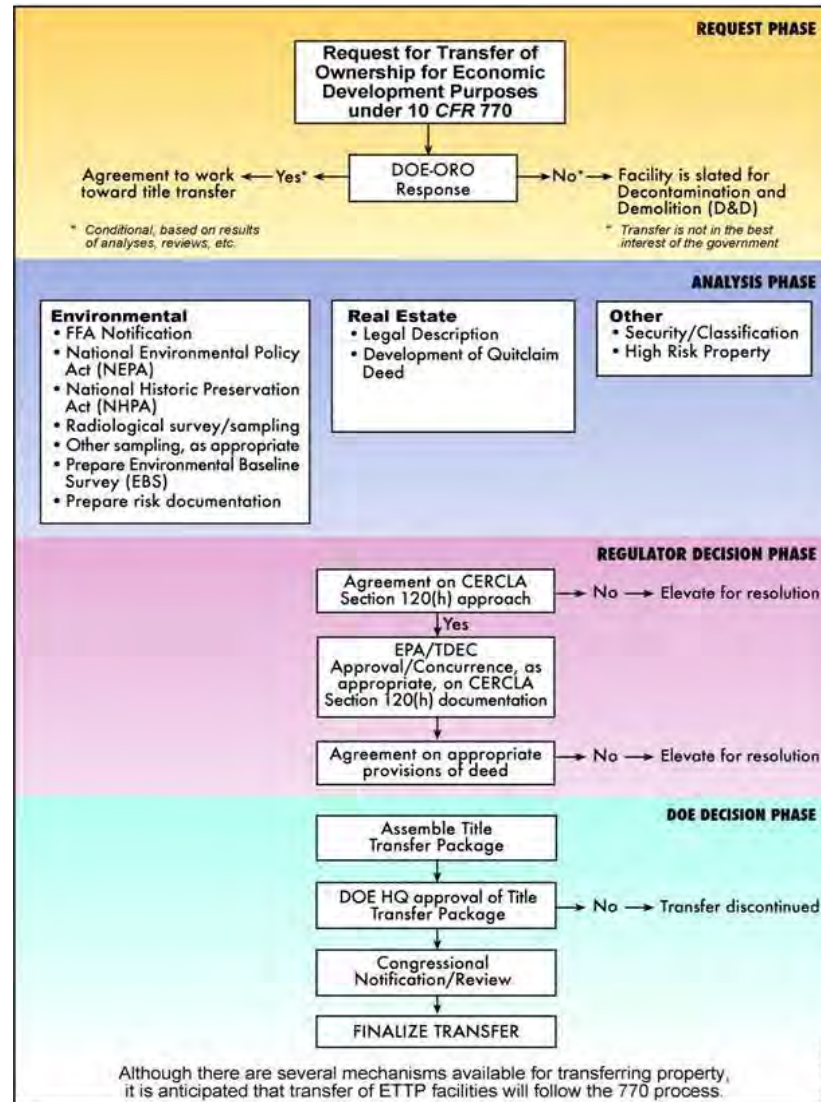


MOVING TO THE FUTURE BY CLEANING UP THE PAST

Metropolitan Knoxville Airport Authority

- **Identified a need for additional carrying capacity for mid-size aircraft**
- **Completed two planning studies that evaluated multiple sites on the Oak Ridge Reservation, resulting in the selection of the proposed location at ETTP**
- **Submitted a request for transfer under 10 CFR 770 in June 2013**
- **Notional schedule is to begin construction by the end of 2017, with the airport operational by the end of 2021**

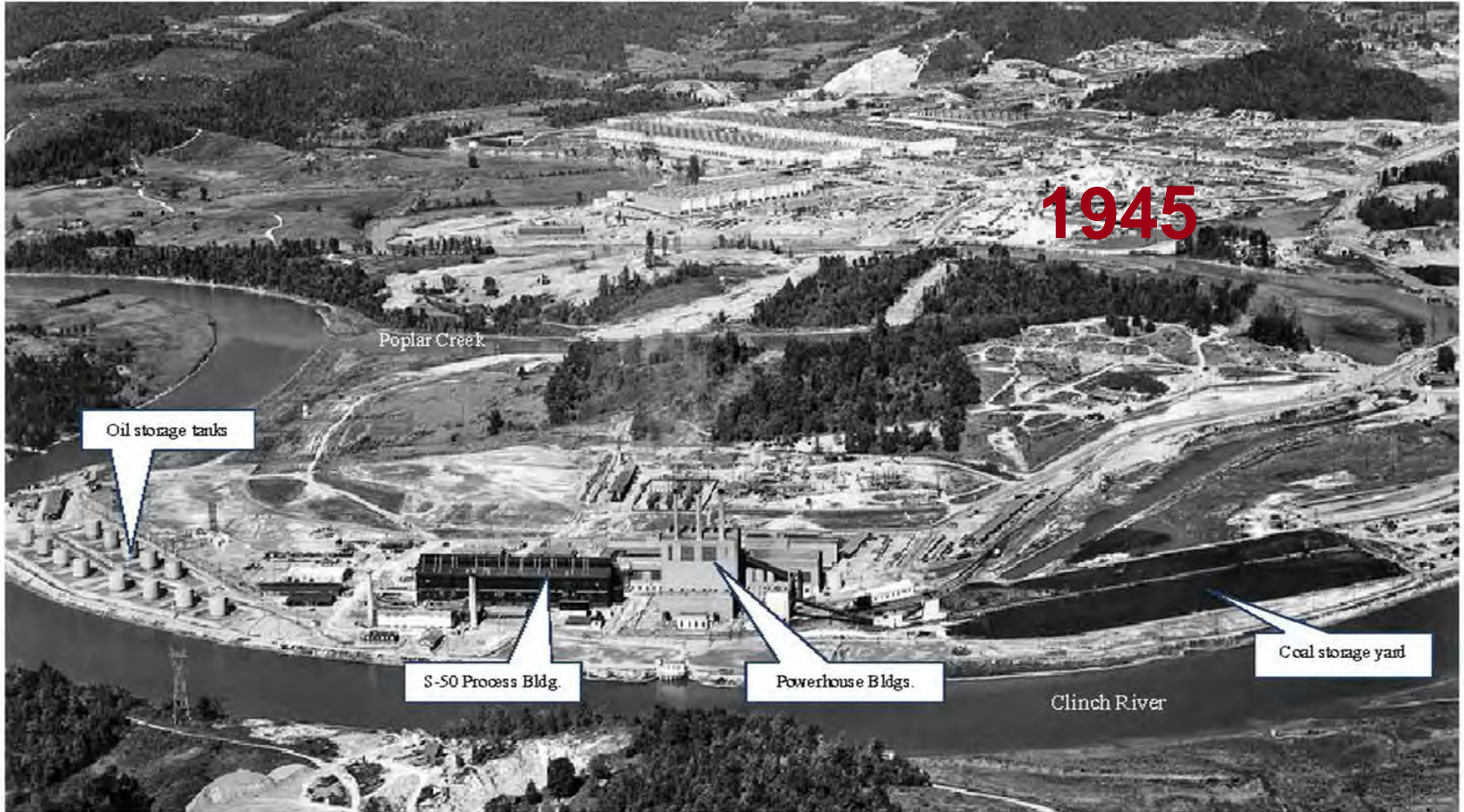

ETTP Heritage Center Summary

- ✓ Transfer of Land and Buildings Underway
 - 230 Acres and 13 Buildings (332,000 sq ft) Transferred to Date
 - Documentation/Review Process Initiated for Transfer of 875 Additional Acres
- ✓ Railroad (11 miles) transferred, rehabilitated, and sold to private sector
- ✓ Water and Sewer System to be Transferred by end 2014
- ✓ Electric Distribution System Transfer Underway
- ✓ Road Transfers Underway (1.3 miles to date)
- ✓ Fire Protection and Emergency Response Services Transferred
- ✓ Safety Oversight Transition to OSHA/TOSHA Underway
- ✓ Expansion of Public Access Area Continues
