**Semi-Annual Report** 

Dear Ms. Moore:

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph G. of DOE/FE Order No. 3447, Emera CNG LLC ("Emera") hereby submits its semi-annual report, for period June 13, 2014 to September 30, 2014, describing the progress of the proposed CNG compression and loading facility. Development activities are continuing pending the DOE/FE order granting long-term authorization to export compressed natural gas by vessel from a proposed CNG compression and loading facility at the Port of Palm Beach, Florida, to non-free trade agreement nations as requested in Emera's application<sup>2</sup>. Emera sought and obtained a declaratory order from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") that FERC did not have jurisdiction over Emera's proposed CNG compression and loading facilities<sup>3</sup>. Accordingly, Emera understands that DOE intends to proceed as the lead agency for the *National Environmental Policy Act* review of Emera's proposed facilities.
