Re: Annova LNG Common Infrastructure, LLC DOE/FE Order Nos. 3394 and 3464 FE Docket Nos. 13-140-LNG and 14-004-CIC Semi-Annual Report

To the Office of Oil and Gas Global Security and Supply:

On February 20, 2014, in Order No. 3394, the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of Fossil Energy ("DOE/OFE"), granted to Annova LNG, LLC a long-term, multi-contract authorization to export liquefied natural gas ("LNG") to Free Trade Agreement ("FTA") nations. Subsequently, on July 17, 2014, in Order No. 3494, DOE/OFE approved the assignment of such authorization to Annova LNG Common Infrastructure, LLC ("ACI"). One of the conditions of the authorization in Order No. 3394 is that ACI file semi-annual written reports describing the progress of the planned liquefaction facility from which ACI would export LNG. Annova Common Infrastructure hereby submits such semi-annual report for the period ending September 30, 2014.

ACI intends to file an application with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") pursuant to Section 3 of the Natural Gas Act for authorization to site, construct, and operate the facilities necessary to export LNG in the fourth quarter of 2015. At this time, ACI plans to start commercial operation of its facilities in 2019. ACI has not yet executed any long-term contracts for the export of LNG or for the supply of natural gas.
