#### **CLARIFICATION OF UNIT**

Pursuant to Section 2422.1 of the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Labor Relations Authority, an amended petition and two additional petitions were filed seeking to clarify the unit of certain employees of the U.S. Department of Energy, National Energy Technology Laboratory, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, represented by the American Federation of Government Employees, Local 1916, AFL-CIO as initially certified in 1974.

On June 4, 2002, I issued a Decision and Order on the Petitions finding that the unit should be clarified by including in that unit the positions of Senior Analyst, GS-801-14/15, GS-1101-14/15, and GS-1301-14/15, in the Strategic Center for Natural Gas and the Office of Coal and Environmental Systems; Senior Management and Technical Advisor, GS/GM-1301-15, in the Office of Science and Technology; and Senior Management and Technical Advisor/Senior Engineering and Management Advisor, GM-801-15, in the Office of System and Policy Support, and by excluding from that unit the positions of Senior Management and Technical Advisor, GS/GM-801-15 and GM-1101-15, in the Office of Coal and Environmental Systems and the Office of Fuels and Energy Efficiency; International Senior Management and Technical Advisor, GS-1301-15, in the Office of System and Policy Support; Product Manager, GS-801-15 and GS-1301-15, in the Office of Coal and Environmental Systems and the Office of Fuels and Energy Efficiency; and Regional Manager, GS-340-15, in the Office of Fuels and Energy Efficiency.

No timely application for review having been filed with the Authority, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Regional Director,

I ORDER that the unit represented by the American Federation of Government Employees, Local 1916, AFL-CIO is clarified to read as follows:

### INCLUDED:

All professional and non-professional employees who occupy positions at the National Energy Technology Laboratory, Pittsburgh. Pennsylvania, site, including Team Leaders and Team Coordinators and including employees in the position of Senior Analyst, GS-801-14/15, GS-1101-14/15, and GS-1301-14/15, in the Strategic Center for Natural Gas and the Office of Coal and Environmental Systems; Senior Management and Technical Advisor, GS/GM-1301-15, in the Office of Science and Technology; and Senior Management and Technical Advisor/Senior Engineering and Management Advisor, GM-801-15, in the Office of System and Policy Support.

#### EXCLUDED:

All supervisors, management officials, confidential employees, and employees engaged in Federal personnel work in other than a purely clerical capacity, and employees in the position of Senior Management and Technical Advisor, GS/GM-801-15 and GM-1101-15, in the Office of Coal and Environmental Systems and the Office of Fuels and Energy Efficiency; International Senior Management and Technical Advisor, GS-1301-15, in the Office of System and Policy Support: Product Manager, GS-801-15 and GS-1301-15, in the Office of Coal and Environmental Systems and the Office of Fuels and Energy Efficiency; and Regional Manager, GS-340-15, in the Office of Fuels and Energy Efficiency.
