I am sending this e-mail as a reminder that the semi-annual report for Barca LNG, LLC, in Docket No. 13-117-LNG/Order No. 3365 was due on October 1, 2014.

Ordering Paragraph J on page 12 of the order states:

Barca shall file with the Office of Natural Gas Regulatory Activities, on a semi-annual basis, written reports describing the progress of the proposed Project in Brownsville, Texas. The reports shall be filed on or by April 1 and October 1 of each year, and shall include information on the progress of the proposed Project, the date the facility is expected to be operational, and the status of the long-term contracts associated with the long-term export of LNG and any long-term supply contracts.

As per the requirements of Docket No. 13-117-LNG/Order No. 3365, the following is an update on the proposed Project in Brownsville, Texas.


Progress of the proposed Project: The project is still in pre-development. We are still actively sourcing offtakers and financing

The date the facility is expected to be operational: If financing is secured by April 1st 2015, we anticipate the project will be operational by Q2 2015

The status of the long-term contracts associated with the long-term export of LNG: Currently there are no long term contracts. The contract with VGS Group is still under negotiation

The status of long-term supply contracts: Currently there are no long term supply contracts for feedstock gas.
