NOTICE OF ALLOWANCE TO RESUME DISTRIBUTION

Issued: December 3, 2014

Manufacturers of certain covered products that the Department of Energy ("DOE") has determined do not comply with an applicable water conservation standard may be allowed to resume distribution in commerce in the United States, as described in 10 C.F.R. § 429.114(d), if the manufacturer modifies the basic model in such a manner as to make it comply with the applicable standards. On October 15, 2014, DOE issued a Notice of Noncompliance Determination, based on enforcement testing, for the basic model that includes Memowell Corporation ("Memowell") showerhead individual model SH1014.

Memowell has informed DOE that it has modified this basic model, now certified by Memowell as basic model number SH1014N and containing the following individual models: SH1010N, SH1010NW, SH1010NB, SH1010NBN, SH1011N, SH1011NW, SH1011NB, SH1011NBN, SH1012NW, SH1012NB, SH1012NBN, SH1013NW, SH1013NBN, SH1013NBN, SH1014NW, SH1014NW, SH1014NBN, SH1015N, SH1015NW, SH1015NB, SH1015NBN, SH1016NN, SH1016NW, SH1016NB, and SH1016NBN. Memowell also provided test results for the modified product from testing performed by a third-party laboratory. These results indicate that the modified basic model complies with the applicable water conservation standard.

Based on the test data for the modified basic model and the certification report from Memowell, DOE has determined that the new basic model appears to comply with the applicable water conservation flow rate standard and is a suitable replacement for the noncompliant model. As such, the company may distribute the individual models listed in the paragraph immediately above. In addition to fulfilling its obligations under 10 C.F.R. Part 429, Memowell must maintain records that demonstrate that compliance modifications have been made to all units prior to importation or any other distribution in commerce. Unmodified units of the basic model that includes individual model SH1014 may not be distributed in commerce in the U.S.
