APPLICATION OF A CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION (CX)

Brief Description of the Action that has been categorically excluded: (indicate the site, location (e.g., building number), and describe the action in 1-3 sentences.

DOE proposes to convey the infrastructure, land, and facilities on an ~ 80 acre parcel of the Portsmouth Gaseous Diffusion Plant (PORTS) real property that is referred to as Parcel 1. The conveyance would be to the Southern Ohio Diversification Initiative (SODI) for the lease/license term for economic development purposes. Activities proposed in the conveyance term include development of plans for property development/design, to conduct marketing and marketing research activities for potential future industries, and to establish a commercial laboratory to serve regional needs on a portion of the property. The land and its associated infrastructure assets are located in the southeast portion of PORTS, adjacent to Perimeter Road and Hewes Street.
