DOE/FE ORDER NO. 4629-A

On December 8, 2020, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) issued DOE/FE Order No. 4629 (the Order) to Epcilon LNG LLC (Epcilon) under section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, 15 U.S.C. § 717b. Under the Order, Epcilon is authorized to export U.S.-sourced natural gas by pipeline from the United States to Mexico and, after liquefaction in Mexico, to re-export the U.S.-sourced natural gas in the form of liquefied natural gas (LNG) from the proposed AMIGO LNG facility to be located in the State of Sonora, Mexico, in a volume equivalent to 395 billion cubic feet per year (Bcf/yr) of natural gas. In relevant part, Epcilon is authorized to re-export the U.S.-sourced natural gas in the form of LNG to both free trade agreement (FTA) and non-FTA countries, as set forth in the Order.

During a routine review, DOE/FE discovered that Ordering Paragraph O of the Order ("Monthly Reports") includes a reference to FTA countries only, when the reference should include non-FTA countries, as well. To ensure the proper scope of Epcilon's reporting requirement, DOE/FE is amending Ordering Paragraph O to add the necessary reference to non-FTA countries.

ORDER

Pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, it is ordered that:

A. In DOE/FE Order No. 4629, the relevant sentence of Ordering Paragraph O (page 59, paragraph 2, sentence 1) is amended to state:

With respect to the re-export of U.S.-sourced natural gas as LNG authorized by this Order, Epcilon shall file with the Office of Regulation, Analysis, and Engagement, within 30 days following the last day of each calendar month, a report on Form FE-746R indicating whether re-exports of this LNG to FTA <u>and non-FTA</u> countries have been made.

B. All other obligations, rights, and responsibilities established by DOE/FE Order No. 4629 remain in effect.
