ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS FROM AND TO CANADA AND MEXICO

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 4564-A

On July 31, 2020, in DOE/FE Order No. 4564, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Infinite Energy, Inc. (Infinite Energy) to import and export a combined total of 0.1 billion cubic feet of natural gas from and to Canada and Mexico. This blanket authorization extends for a two-year term beginning on August 21, 2020, and extending through August 20, 2022.

On May 3, 2021, Infinite Energy notified DOE/FE that it no longer needs the blanket authorization. Infinite Energy therefore asks DOE/FE to vacate Order No. 4564, effective May 3, 2021. DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Infinite Energy's blanket authorization granted in DOE/FE Order No. 4564 is hereby vacated, effective May 3, 2021.
