The FY22 Budget Request focuses on approaches across varying levels of technological readiness that help to ensure clean and affordable energy, while assisting in facilitating the transition toward a net-zero carbon economy and building a U.S. critical minerals supply chain.



FACT#3

This funding will support advancing technologies that reduce carbon emissions and other environmental impacts of fossil fuel production and use, particularly the hardest-to-decarbonize applications in the electricity and industrial sectors.



FACT #2

President Biden's FY22 Budget Request seeks \$890 million for the Fossil Energy and Carbon Management Research, Development, Demonstration and Deployment (RDD&D) program.



FACT #4

Specifically, the FY22 Budget Request supports advancing point-source carbon capture, carbon-neutral hydrogen, methane emissions reduction, critical mineral production and carbon dioxide (CO_2) removal to address the accumulated CO_2 emissions in the atmosphere.



These investments will enable the commercialization of clean energy innovations that will create jobs, support communities that have been impacted the most from pollution and climate change and result in a more geographically diverse and impactful research portfolio.
