ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO VACATE LONG-TERM AUTHORIZATIONS TO EXPORT COMPRESSED NATURAL GAS TO FREE TRADE AGREEMENT AND NON-FREE TRADE AGREEMENT NATIONS

DOE/FECM ORDER NOS. 3447-A AND 3727-A

Emera CNG, LLC (Emera) holds two long-term authorizations issued by the Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management (FECM)¹ of the Department of Energy (DOE) under section 3 of the Natural Gas Act (NGA).² Under these orders, Emera is currently authorized to export domestically produced compressed natural gas (CNG) from the proposed CNG compression and loading facility to be located at the Port of Palm Beach, in Riviera Beach, Florida (Facility), as follows:

- Under DOE/FE Order No. 3447,³ in a volume equivalent to 9.125 billion cubic feet per year (Bcf/yr) of natural gas for a 20-year term, to any country with which the United States has, or in the future will have, a free trade agreement (FTA) requiring national treatment for trade in natural gas (FTA countries), pursuant to NGA section 3(c),⁴ and
- Under DOE/FE Order No. 3727,⁵ in a volume equivalent to 2.92 Bcf/yr of natural gas for a term of 20 years, to any other country with which the United States does not have a FTA requiring national treatment for trade in natural gas, and with which trade is not prohibited by U.S. law or policy (non-FTA countries), pursuant to NGA section 3(a).⁶

On September 21, 2021, Emera submitted a request for DOE to vacate both of these orders (Request).⁷ In support of this Request, Emera states that the Facility—the source of Emera's authorized exports—never entered operation. ⁸

FTAs with Israel and Costa Rica do not require national treatment for trade in natural gas.
