Public Citizen, Inc. moves to intervene in U.S. Department of Energy Docket Nos. 21-131-LNG, 13-69-LNG, 14-88-LNG and 15-25-LNG.

Docket No. 21-131-LNG is Venture Global CP2 LNG, LLC’s Application for Long-Term Authorization To Export Liquefied Natural Gas to Non-Free Trade Agreement Nations. Docket Nos. 13-69-LNG, 14-88-LNG and 15-25-LNG is Venture Global Calcasieu Pass, LLC’s Application for Limited Amendment to Existing Long-Term, Multi-Contract Authorization To Export Liquefied Natural Gas to Non-Free Trade Agreement Nations.
