Vista Pacifico LNG, S.A.P.I. de C.V. ("Vista Pacifico") respectfully submits this letter in response to the Department of Energy ("DOE") Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management's ("DOE/FECM") Notice of Environmental Assessment ("EA Notice"), issued on July 12, 2022, in the above-referenced docket.¹

On November 18, 2020, Vista Pacifico filed an application requesting long-term, multi-contract authorization to export natural gas by pipeline to Mexico for use in the proposed Topolobampo liquefaction and export terminal facilities, where the gas would be liquefied and re-exported by vessel to Free Trade Agreement ("FTA") and Non-Free Trade Agreement ("Non-FTA") countries (the "Application").² On April 9, 2021, DOE granted the FTA portion of the Application pursuant to section 3(c) of the Natural Gas Act ("NGA"). The unopposed, Non-FTA portion of the Application remains pending.

On July 12, 2022, DOE issued the EA Notice, which announced DOE's intent to undertake an environmental assessment ("EA") under the National Environmental Policy Act ("NEPA") to analyze Vista Pacifico's request to export U.S.-sourced LNG to non-FTA countries. The EA Notice identifies four topics to be analyzed in the EA. Furthermore, DOE has provided notice to

Notice of the non-FTA portion of the Application was issued in the *Federal Register* on December 8, 2020, and the comment period closed on February 8, 2021. No comments, protests, or interventions were filed, and accordingly as noted in the EA Notice, "the non-FTA portion of the Application is uncontested." EA Notice at 4.

the cross-border host states of Arizona, Texas, and California and to all tribes on or within 100 kilometers of the U.S. border in those states, pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 1021.301(c). According to the EA Notice, DOE expects to complete the EA by the end of October 2022.

While DOE's decision to prepare an EA in this proceeding departs from precedent³ and does not appear to be required under the applicable regulations,⁴ Vista Pacifico views this as an opportunity for DOE to move forward with a prompt and orderly approval of its uncontested Non-FTA Application.

Consistent with the EA Notice, Vista Pacifico expects that the EA in this proceeding will be issued no later than the end of October 2022. Upon the EA's issuance, Vista Pacifico understands that DOE will provide an opportunity to comment on the EA to the host states of Arizona, Texas, and California and to tribes on or within 100 kilometers of the U.S. border in those states. See 10 C.F.R. § 1021.301(d). Pursuant to DOE's regulations, this review and comment period may last between 14 to 30 days. *Id.* Furthermore, to the extent DOE considers any comments as part of this review, such comments must be restricted to the topics that are the subject of the EA. Vista Pacifico respectfully notes that the comment period for the Non-FTA Application closed on February 8, 2021, with no interventions, protests, or comments filed. Thus, any new comments that bear on DOE's public interest review under the NGA may not be entertained at this juncture.

Vista Pacifico looks forward to cooperating with DOE during this process to facilitate a timely review and decision on the Non-FTA portion of the Application.
