Pursuant to the above-referenced Orders, Cheniere Marketing, LLC ("CMLLC") and Corpus Christi Liquefaction, LLC ("CCL") herein submit the semi-annual report for March 1, 2022, through August 31, 2022. This report includes a list of the items which have been filed during the reporting period relating to long-term contracts associated with the long-term export of LNG from the Corpus Christi LNG Terminal, as well as long-term gas supply contracts.

Please note that on July 5, 2022, CCL provided notice to the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management that a merger of Corpus Christi Liquefaction Stage III, LLC ("CCL Stage III") into CCL occurred effective June 15, 2022. Therefore, as CCL is the surviving entity, the semi-annual report for FE Docket No. 18-78-LNG is provided herein and will be submitted by CCL on a go forward basis.

- CCL and CMLLC submitted the following new long-term contract(s) associated with the long-term export of LNG from the Corpus Christi LNG Terminal during the reporting period:
  - On May 25, 2022, CMLLC entered into an agreement with Posco International Corporation for the long-term sale and export of liquefied natural gas from the Corpus Christi LNG Terminal.
  - On June 8, 2022, CMLLC entered into an agreement with Equinor ASA for the long-term sale and export of liquefied natural gas from the Corpus Christi LNG Terminal.
  - On June 15, 2022, CCL entered into an agreement with Polskie Gornictwo Naftowe I Gazownictwo S.A. for the long-term sale and export of liquefied natural gas from the Corpus Christi LNG Terminal.
  - On June 15, 2022, Cheniere Marketing International LLP ("CMI") and CCL (as successor to CCL Stage III) entered into an agreement for the for the long-term sale and export of liquefied natural gas from the Corpus Christi LNG Terminal.

- On June 21, 2022, CMLLC entered into an agreement with Chevron U.S.A. Inc. for the long-term sale and export of liquefied natural gas from the Corpus Christi LNG Terminal
- On July 15, 2022, CMLLC entered into an agreement with PetroChina International Company Limited for the long-term sale and export of liquefied natural gas from the Corpus Christi LNG Terminal.
- On July 22, 2022, CMLLC entered into an agreement with PTT Global LNG Company Limited for the long-term sale and export of liquefied natural gas from the Corpus Christi LNG Terminal.
- CCL and CMLLC submitted the following item(s) related to previously entered long-term contracts associated with the long-term export of LNG:
  - On March 4, 2022, CCL and Engie SA (“Engie”) entered into an Amended and Restated LNG Sale and Purchase Agreement, which amends and restates the previously submitted LNG sale and purchase agreement entered into by CCL and Engie on June 23, 2021.
  - On June 15, 2022, CMI, CCL, and CPC Corporation, Taiwan (“CPC”) entered into a Novation and Amendment Agreement, which amends and assigns to CCL the previously submitted LNG sale and purchase agreement entered into by CMI and CPC on August 11, 2018.
  - On June 15, 2022, CMI, CCL and Foran Energy Group Co. Ltd. (“Foran”) entered into a Novation and Amendment Agreement, which amends and assigns to CCL the LNG sale and purchase agreement entered into by CMI and Foran on November 24, 2021.
  - On June 15, 2022, CMLLC, CCL, and Sinochem Group Co., Ltd. (“Sinochem”) entered into a Novation and Amendment Deed, which amends and assigns to CCL the previously submitted LNG sale and purchase agreement entered into by CMLLC and Sinochem on November 4, 2021.
  - On June 15, 2022, CMI and CCL entered into a Second Amended and Restated Base LNG Sale and Purchase Agreement, which amends and restates the previously submitted amended and restated base LNG sale and purchase agreement entered into by CMI and CCL on November 28, 2014.
- CCL and CMLLC submitted the following new long-term gas supply contract(s) during the reporting period:
  - On May 2, 2022, CCL (as successor to CCL Stage III) entered into a Gas Supply Agreement with ARC Resources U.S. Corp. for an annual contract quantity approximating 50,000,000 MMBtu.
