#### **Contract Scope**

#### Milestone 1

 Complete relocation of 275 HLW canisters and 3 non-conforming HLW canisters to Long-term Interim Storage (Completed February 2017)

#### Milestone 2

 Process, ship, dispose of all Legacy Waste, not including Transuranic Waste (Completed September 2018)

#### Milestone 3

 Demolish and remove the Vitrification Facility and Main Plant Process Building (Ongoing – Demolition of MPPB deferred)

#### Milestone 4

 Complete all work in Performance Work Statement, including Balance of Site Facilities, Surveillance and Maintenance, and Site Operations (Ongoing)

#### **2018 Accomplishments**

- Continued to perform all work safely and compliantly
- Completed Milestone 2 Legacy Waste Disposition seven months ahead of schedule
- Completed demolition of the Vitrification Facility
- Achieved significant progress on deactivation of the Main Plant Process Building for future demolition
  - Completed the removal of the Main Plant ventilation stack
  - Completed MSM Shop and Contact-Size Reduction Facility demolitions
- Completed major site infrastructure upgrades
- Completed demolition of 28 Balance of Site Facilities (28 of 47) and areas restored
- Conducted support initiatives to benefit local communities




Waste disposition in Vitrification Facility demolition area


# Main Plant Process Building Deactivation (MPPB) – Milestone 3

- Five crews are performing deactivation and decontamination in MPPB
  - Asbestos-containing material (ACM) removal
  - · Deactivation in radiological areas
- Major areas left for deactivation, which are also the most challenging include:
  - Vent Exhaust Cell (VEC) Completed final cleanup from roof vent duct removal activities.
  - Vent Wash Room Completed final cleanup of excess tools, equipment and supplies used to perform deactivation in the area. Removed ACM containment tent from in front of the room.
  - Chemical Process Cell Completed draining fluids from the man-lift in the Equipment Decontamination Room in preparation for future CHBWV removal.

## Balance of Site Facilities (BOSF) and Infrastructure – Milestone 4

- Performing deactivation to support removal of 47 Balance of Site Facilities
  - North Plateau Pump and Treat System demolished and the area restored
  - 28 facilities demolished and areas restored
- Reconfiguring infrastructure for facility demolition and future site needs
  - Work completed on the new natural gas distribution system
    - 2,800 feet of new pipeline installed
  - New electrical substation
    - Phase 1 completed
    - Phase 2 Spring 2019

#### **2018 Community Support**

- United Way: \$18,375








  - Contract modifications underway for additional deactivation scope in place of MPPB demolition









