Our overarching goal is to enhance the performance of CO2 capture capabilities. This goal will be achieved by a systematic and comprehensive investigation combining atomistic simulations, theoretical and numerical gas transport models, and advanced polymer synthesis and characterization techniques that can aid in elucidating the relationships between the chemical composition of supramolecules and ionic liquids, non-bonded interactions, polymer structural dynamics, and gas transport and self-healing properties. The project will leverage a wide range of resources and scientific expertise across institutions in multiple jurisdictions: the University of Vermont, the University of Alabama, and the DOE-Oak Ridge National Laboratory.
