Re: Approval of Dominion Cove Point LNG, LP's Application for Long-term Authority to Export LNG to Non-Free Trade Agreement Countries (FE Docket No. 11-128-LNG)


Dear Ms. Moore:

I am writing to you today on behalf of Pacific Summit Energy LLC (a wholly-owned subsidiary of Sumitomo Corporation, "PSE") in support of the application for long-term, multi-contract authorization to engage in exports of domestically produced LNG to any country that has or in the future develops the capacity to import LNG via ocean-going carrier and with which the U.S. does not prohibit trade but also does not have a Free Trade Agreement ("Non-FTA Application") filed with the Department of Energy, Office of Fossil Energy ("DOE/FE") in FE Docket No. 11-128-LNG by Dominion Cove Point LNG, LP ("Dominion").

As stated in Dominion's recent filing in the above-referenced docket, "Update of Dominion Cove Point LNG, LP Concerning Signed LNG Export Contracts," PSE entered into a Terminal Service Agreement ("TSA") with Dominion on December 28, 2012. The TSA allows PSE to deliver natural gas to Dominion at the Cove Point LNG terminal for liquefaction and thereafter export such natural gas as LNG for delivery to buyers in Japan. The TSA and other related agreements between PSE and Dominion will help meet the significant and increasing demand for natural gas in Japan. The approval of Dominion's Non-FTA Application is an integral step in implementing the commercial framework created under the TSA.

We greatly appreciate the opportunity to provide this letter in support of Dominion's Non-FTA Application and your time and consideration hereof. We look forward to building a long-term relationship not only with Dominion, but also with DOE/FE, and we would be pleased to provide any further information that may assist you in expediting your determination in this matter.
