Identified through research and consultation.

What has been completed so far?

- Buildings have been documented through a report and inventory of all of Area IV, including evaluations for technological/scientific importance.
- Archaeological sites on Area IV have been identified.

What remains to be done:

- Area IV: confirm evaluation of National Register eligibility of identified sites.
- Northern Undeveloped Lands: survey for all cultural resources.
- Identify properties of traditional cultural and religious importance on Area IV and Northern Undeveloped Lands.
- Listen to concerns regarding all types of cultural resources on SSFL Area IV and Northern Undeveloped Lands

Procedures for archaeological survey:

- Where possible, walk closely-spaced transects;
- Look at all outcrops and exposures, caves and rockshelters, within limits of safety.
- Record all archaeological and architectural resources to State of California standards.
