Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to issue a Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) titled "Resilient and Efficient Codes Implementation". The FOA would award funds toward advancing building energy codes and other building efficiency policies within regional, state, and local jurisdictions.

This NEPA Determination (ND) covers all topic areas under this FOA including the advancement of energy codes and policies via state and local code adoption, workforce development, implementation and compliance planning, innovation, energy and environmental justice, and partnerships with national, regional, and state energy code collaborative organizations focusing on education, training, outreach and technical assistance.

FOA activities of any awardee would include only intellectual, academic, or analytical activities such as administrative and educational activities. DOE does not anticipate any impacts to resources of concern.

The proposed action (or the part of the proposal defined in the Rationale above) fits within a class of actions that is listed in Appendix A or B to 10 CFR Part 1021, Subpart D.
