Dear Secretary Granholm and distinguished members of the Secretary of Energy Advisory Board:

The *Secure the Grid Coalition* greatly appreciates the opportunity to voice recommendations to the SEAB for consideration during its January 24, 2023, virtual meeting.

## (1) We would first like to commend Secretary Granholm for her <u>October 21, 2022 public</u> <u>statement</u> on the "importance of developing practical uses for America's used nuclear fuel" and for investing in this concept.

As you will recall, last January, our Secure the Grid Coalition made <u>several recommendations</u> during the SEAB's January 25, 2022 meeting, including that the DOE adopt the concept of recycling spent nuclear fuel as a new "Energy Earthshot" Initiative.

Therefore, we were very pleased to see that DOE's Advanced Research Projects Agency-Energy (ARPA-E) has begun making major investments in projects aimed at spent nuclear fuel recycling through the CURIE program.

We are especially excited to see that one of these investments is in <u>Curio</u> - a nuclear technology innovation and commercialization company - and their innovative NuCycle recycling process.

We highly recommend that the SEAB schedule a briefing by the Curio CEO, if this has not already been arranged.

(2) Secondly, we want to make you aware of a recently launched documentary film titled <u>Grid</u> <u>Down, Power Up</u> by producer David Tice.


This film debuted in Hollywood last week to a standing-room-only audience and is now being viewed by Americans nationwide.
