ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO MEXICO

DOE/FECM ORDER NO. 4817-A

On May 9, 2022, in DOE/FECM Order No. 4817, the Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon

Management (FECM) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to West

Texas Gas, Inc. (West Texas Gas) to export 50 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas to Mexico

by pipeline. This blanket authorization extends for a two-year term that began on June 1, 2022,

and extends through May 31, 2024.

On January 25, 2023, West Texas Gas notified DOE that this authorization is no longer

needed.¹ West Texas Gas, therefore, requests that DOE vacate Order No. 4817, effective March

1, 2023.2 DOE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, West Texas Gas' blanket

authorization to export 50 Bcf of natural gas to Mexico, granted in DOE/FECM Order No. 4817

on May 9, 2022, is hereby vacated, effective March 1, 2023.
