

Recharging Industry: Request for Information Workshops on Domestic Manufacturing Conversion Grants for Electrified Vehicles

The [Office of Manufacturing and Energy Supply Chains \(MESC\)](#) will hold two workshops that will provide a forum for stakeholders to share perspectives on opportunities and challenges for the domestic conversion of manufacturing across the supply chain towards the vision and goals of the landmark Inflation Reduction Act of 2022 (IRA) Section 50143. Interested parties may sign up to attend either workshop and can submit a 3-minute video providing their perspectives on this program, if they desire.

Workshops will be held on:

- May 4, 2023 from 1:00 – 5:00 p.m. ET
- May 5, 2023 from 1:00 – 5:00 p.m. ET

The deadline to submit videos to be aired during the live events will be **April 25, 2023**. Videos will be made publicly available on the MESC webpage following the event. (Please review the additional information below). However, MESC reserves the right to exclude submitted videos if a submission exceeds 3 minutes or is determined inappropriate for the workshop.

Submitted presentations will be used for planning purposes, which could include developing future Funding Opportunity Announcements (FOA) or other solicitations, as well as assist MESC in disseminating information on the important challenges and opportunities for industry in converting domestic manufacturing for electrified vehicles.

Suggested content for presentations: (videos will be shared widely and publicly):

- Company and/or Manufacturing Facility overview and capabilities, current and future status
- Relevant technology characteristics, benefits, and limitations or barriers
- Existing workforce capabilities and benefits, or workforce needs and requirements (skill/level needed, expansion of workforce needed)
- Approaches for increasing community involvement and ensuring environmental justice
- Other relevant information that may help the U.S. establish a manufacturing base for electrified vehicles

Video Guidance:

- Videos should be maximum **3 minutes** in length.
 - Horizontal recording is preferred
