ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO VACATE LONG-TERM AUTHORIZATION TO EXPORT LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS TO FREE TRADE AGREEMENT NATIONS AND TO WITHDRAW PENDING APPLICATION TO EXPORT LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS TO NON-FREE TRADE AGREEMENT NATIONS

DOE/FECM ORDER NO. 3682-B

On July 17, 2015, in Docket No. 15-44-LNG, the Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management (FECM)¹ of the Department of Energy (DOE) issued DOE/FE Order No. 3682² to G2 Net-Zero LNG LLC (G2 LNG) (then G2 LNG LLC) under section 3(c) of the Natural Gas Act (NGA).³ Under this order, G2 LNG is authorized to export domestically produced liquefied natural gas (LNG) in a volume equivalent to approximately 672 billion cubic feet per year (Bcf/yr) of natural gas for a term of 30 years. G2 LNG may export the LNG from the proposed G2 LNG Terminal, to be located in Cameron Parish, Louisiana, to countries with which the United States currently has, or in the future will have, a free trade agreement (FTA) requiring national treatment for trade in natural gas (FTA countries).⁴

Additionally, on March 19, 2015, in Docket No. 15-45-LNG, G2 LNG filed an application (Application) with DOE requesting authorization to export domestically produced LNG in a volume equivalent to approximately 672 Bcf/yr of natural gas from the proposed G2 LNG Terminal to countries with which the United States does not have a FTA requiring national treatment for trade in natural gas, and with which trade is not prohibited by U.S. law or policy (non-FTA countries). This non-FTA Application, filed under NGA section 3(a), is pending before DOE.

On March 29, 2023, G2 LNG submitted a request asking DOE to: (i) vacate DOE/FE Order No. 3682, as amended, and (ii) withdraw the pending non-FTA Application (Request). In support of this Request, G2 LNG states that its "corporate focus has shifted away from LNG export activities to development of net-zero greenhouse gas emission energy products," and that it "recently decided to cease development of its previously planned natural gas liquefaction facilities in Cameron Parish, Louisiana."

Accordingly, pursuant to NGA section 3(c), DOE grants G2 LNG's request to vacate DOE/FE Order No. 3682, as amended, in Docket No. 15-44-LNG. Additionally, DOE finds good cause to grant G2 LNG's request to withdraw the Application in Docket No. 15-45-LNG, pursuant to NGA section 3(a) and 10 C.F.R. § 590.204(c). Both actions are effective immediately.
