Sabine Pass Liquefaction, LLC ("Sabine Pass") hereby submits<sup>1</sup> for filing under seal, a non-redacted copy of NAESB Base Contract for Sale and Purchase of Natural Gas ("Base Contract") and a Transaction Confirmation ("Confirmation"), entered into by Sabine Pass on April 14, 2016 and October 28, 2020 (respectively) with Wells Fargo Commodities, LLC ("Counterparty"). Under the Base Contract and Confirmation, Counterparty will sell and Sabine Pass will purchase natural gas on a long-term basis.
