Sabine Pass Liquefaction, LLC ("Sabine Pass") hereby submits¹ for filing under seal, a non-redacted copy of a NAESB Base Contract for Sale and Purchase of Natural Gas ("Base Contract"), Transaction Confirmation A and Transaction Confirmation B ("Confirmations"), entered into by Sabine Pass on March 17, 2017, August 8, 2019 and August 27, 2019 (respectively) with Indigo Minerals LLC ("Indigo"). Under the Base Contract and Confirmations, Indigo will sell and Sabine Pass will purchase natural gas on a long-term basis. Sabine Pass intends to liquefy the natural gas purchased from Indigo at the Sabine Pass LNG Terminal.

Sabine Pass is also filing herewith a public summary of the major provisions of the contracts. Similarly, in respect of any day, the Buyer is obliged to take a specified quantity of gas, or compensate the Seller if not taken, unless otherwise excused under the contract.
