ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA BY TRUCK, AND
TO EXPORT LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS TO CANADA BY TRUCK

DOE/FECM ORDER NO. 4782-A

On January 7, 2022, in DOE/FECM Order No. 4782, the Office of Fossil Energy and

Carbon Management (FECM) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization

to Plum Gas Solutions Inc. (Plum Gas Solutions) to import liquefied natural gas (LNG) from

Canada by truck, and to export LNG to Canada by truck, in a combined total volume equivalent

to 1 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas. This blanket authorization extends for a two-year

term that began on January 14, 2022, and extends through January 13, 2024.

On August 4, 2023, Plum Gas Solutions notified DOE that this authorization is no longer

needed.¹ Plum Gas Solutions therefore requests that DOE vacate Order No. 4782, effective

August 1, 2023.² DOE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Plum Gas Solutions' blanket

authorization to import LNG from Canada by truck, and to export LNG to Canada by truck, in a

combined total volume equivalent to 1 Bcf of natural gas, granted in DOE/FECM Order No.

4782 on January 7, 2022, is hereby vacated, effective August 1, 2023.
