Re: Lake Charles LNG

Ladies and Gentlemen:

EQT Corporation ("EQT") is the largest producer of natural gas in the United States with an evolutionary focus on our future. EQT has operations in the Appalachian Basin and is dedicated to responsibly developing our world-class asset base locally, while also transporting gas to the Gulf Coast, Midwest, and Northeast United States. Our culture prioritizes operational efficiency, technology, and sustainability, and we look to continuously improve the way we produce environmentally responsible, reliable, and low-cost energy.

In June 2023, EQT entered into a Heads of Agreement with Lake Charles LNG related to a longterm tolling agreement whereby EQT would provide a portion of the natural gas supply for Lake Charles LNG and EQT would receive a portion of the LNG production from Lake Charles LNG. We are currently in discussions with Lake Charles LNG to convert the Heads of Agreement to a definitive longterm tolling agreement.

We understand that Lake Charles LNG has filed an application with the Department of Energy for authorization of exports of LNG to non-free trade agreement countries. We have spent considerable time and effort in evaluating various U.S. LNG export projects and are cognizant of the significant progress that Lake Charles LNG has made in developing its project.

EQT understands that President Biden supports the increased export of LNG produced in the United States to provide clean energy to our allies, particularly in Europe. Furthermore, United States Secretary of Energy, Jennifer Granholm, stated in a letter to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission earlier this year that natural gas and the infrastructure that supports its use can play an important role in the clean energy transition. We agree and therefore support the U.S. LNG industry, including the Lake Charles LNG project.

We urge the Department of Energy to carefully consider Lake Charles LNG's application for LNG export authorization and to act in an expeditious manner to approve this application to allow this project to reach final investment decision.
