**ORDER**

For the U.S. Department of Energy:

1. Under the above listed case number, the U.S. Department of Energy (“DOE”) initiated a case against Miele, Inc. (“Respondent”) to pursue a civil penalty for knowingly distributing in commerce in the United States dishwashers that failed to meet the applicable energy conservation standard.
2. Model PG 8056 U AE (the “basic model”) is a standard size dishwasher manufactured on or after May 30, 2013.
3. Respondent submitted a Concession Statement on June 27, 2023, conceding that the basic model does not comply with the applicable DOE energy conservation standards.
4. From January 2020 through April 2023, Respondent distributed in commerce in the United States multiple units of the basic model.
5. Respondent knowingly distributed in commerce multiple units of new covered products which were not in conformity with an applicable energy conservation standard.
6. Based on the information above, I find that Respondent knowingly committed Prohibited Acts by manufacturing and distributing in commerce multiple units of new covered products that were not in conformity with the applicable energy conservation standard. *See* 42 U.S.C. § 6302; 10 C.F.R. §§ 429.102(a)(6), 430.32(f).
7. Accordingly, pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 429.120 and 42 U.S.C. § 6303, I **HEREBY ASSESS** a civil penalty of \$100,000 **AND ORDER** that the Settlement Agreement attached to this Order is adopted.
