Proposed Action Title: Alcova Switchyard Emergency Mobile Transformer Installation

Location: Natrona County, Wyoming

A. PROPOSED ACTION DESCRIPTION:

Western Area Power Administration (WAPA), Rocky Mountain Region (RMR), conducted an emergency mobile transformer installation at Alcova (A) Switchyard between August 12 and September 30, 2023, in Natrona County, Wyoming. This mobile transformer installation was necessary to allow RMR to take the existing transformer offline for emergency troubleshooting and maintenance to address combustible gas buildup. The mobile transformer installation activities included installation of a new section of grounding grid, pad construction, placement of the mobile transformer unit, construction of a spill control berm, and installation of a shoo-fly consisting of two temporary wood poles and associated conductor to connect the mobile transformer with the Alcova Switchyard. Equipment used for this project included crane trucks, backhoe, bucket trucks, dump trucks, excavator, skid-steer, and utility trucks. This work occurred within and outside of the existing fenced perimeter of the A Switchyard, all within WAPA's existing right-of-way (ROW) on Bureau of Reclamation project lands. The ROW was accessed by existing access routes; no new road construction occurred.

This Categorical Exclusion (CX) covers work that has already been completed. No further work is authorized under this CX. If additional work is required, RMR's Environment Department must be contacted to determine whether additional environmental review is required.
